Poster Presentations

Posters will be displayed on a table provided by the OAHQ program team. Tabletop posters must be able to be freestanding or supported on the table by some mechanism. Poster size should be no more than 4 x 8.

Presenters must be at the poster board during break times for questions.

Poster presenters can set up their displays on Wednesday, May 2 between 5:00 PM and 7:00 PM or no later than 7:30 a.m. on May 3, 2012. Posters must remain on display throughout the entire conference. If you are planning on attending only the first day, please make arrangements for someone to take your poster down at the end of the conference.

The poster winner awards will be announced on the second day of the Conference. . The first place winner receives registration for the 2013 OAHQ conference and free membership. Second place winner receives registration for the 2013 conference. Third place winner receives free 2013 OAHQ membership.

Poster Content

The poster content should be well organized and tell the project story. When the attendees have reviewed your poster, they should be able to relate what your project was, methodology / interventions used, the results achieved and next steps.
